Reason and goal

Digitalization and European focus necessary

• In Europe, the rail industry faces challenges with workforce diversity and employability amid rapid digitalization. Without intervention, it risks falling behind in the digital era and missing out on new opportunities. Additionally, there's a need to shift from national to European perspectives to enhance attractiveness and competitiveness, facilitating seamless border crossings.

Harmonized education and training on all levels

The International Command, Control and Signaling + (CCS+) Education programme aims to unify rail sector education, making it more appealing, reducing training time, and fostering internationalization. This supports European initiatives like ERTMS (European Rail Traffic Management System) and the Single European Railway Area under the Green Deal.

Target groups

The International CCS+ Education Programme focuses on three target groups with a specific programme for each target group:

- University students
 - Master's degree
- Rail Newcomers/Young professionals
 - > 1- 4 years' experience in digital rail
- High(er) Management
 - Board of directors in railway organizations, Ministry, EU
- Expert Meetings
 - Network of professionals from all groups

University students

International Master

- The project aims to create an Erasmus Mundus Joint Master program uniting European universities for comprehensive rail-related education. A curriculum board of academic and industry experts will guide content to meet technological and internationalization challenges, incorporating IT, AI, and cross-border knowledge alongside existing rail-related subjects.
 - Full (accredited 120 EC) Master
 - Broad scope within the topic 'digitalization in rail'
 - Join forces with universities in different countries instead of not being able to offer
 - a full program as a single university
 - Minimum of three countries (key universities) needed for financial support from Erasmus+ funds
 - First round to gauge interest
 - Basis for an international career in the (digital) rail industry

- Two-week all-inclusive programme
- In three different European countries
- Lectures from university professors and experts from the rail industry
- Group assignments on current topics
- Technical visits
- Social program
- Networking
